

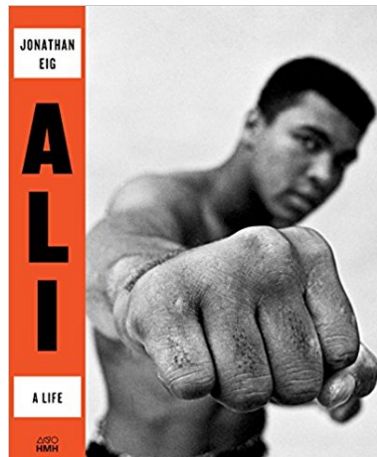

Muhammad Ali (1946-2016) was one of the most influential athletes in American history – a three-time heavyweight boxing champion of the world who fought with his mouth and mind, as well as with his fists.



Ali called himself “The Greatest,” and many agreed. He was the wittiest, the prettiest, the brashest, the baddest, the fastest, the loudest, the rashest.

Now comes the **first complete, unauthorized biography** of one of the twentieth century’s most famous figures. It’s based on more than 500 interviews with most almost all of Ali’s surviving associates and enhanced by the author’s discovery of thousands of pages of FBI records and newly uncovered Ali interviews from the 1960s. Learn about this stunning portrait and about this man who became a legend and continues to fascinate us to this day.
